Rules & Regulations:

- 1. Parade will leave the staging area at 7:00 p.m. and travel through the fairgrounds.
- 3. First through third place will be awarded to participants in Classes I through III.
- 5. Floats must be the work of the organization entering the parade and be no smaller than 6'x10' and no semi-trailers.
- 6. Parading animals will not be considered part of the float exhibit. Must clean up after animals.
- 7. Floats will enter grounds at North Brim Road (Gate E) and proceed north of campers to Derby Lane.
- * *No candy should be thrown while parading.
- 8. A Senior Fair Director will help direct you to your position. Numbers will be posted on the fence.
- 9. Floats should be in designated judging area on Deere/Camper Rd in the campgrounds. Judging will begin at 5 p.m. Those not ready will be penalized. The driver, advisors and only club members to be interviewed should be in judging area after 5 p.m.

10. Floats will be judged according to the following score card:

Organization identification (Large enough to see well)

Interview (brief interview of club members chosen at random by judges)

Posterboard of float construction (standard size)

Appearance (attractive, originality, general idea, theme, neatness)

Eye catching (your first impression)

Art Principle (line, proportion, balance)
