Late applications will not be accepted. (No Nomination Form/No Resume=No Interview or Parade Participation)

An informational email will be sent to each candidate after May 7th. Contest interviews will be held on July 11th. *Each Candidate will be notified of their interview time via email, and must attend the interview as well as the dinner*. Expectations for the King, Queen and Court:
